**ORDER REGARDING ADDITIONAL BRIEFING**

As stated on the record during today's hearing, it appears likely that Plaintiff Doughtie has established Article III standing. No later than 21 days from today, the Attorney General may submit a brief addressing the merits and responding to both pending summary-judgment motions. (The Attorney General may also further address standing.) Within 14 days thereafter, the City may file a supplemental brief responding to the Attorney General's filing. Within 14 days thereafter, Plaintiff Doughtie may file a supplemental brief responding to the Attorney General's and the City's filings.

The City addressed abstention today but not in its briefing. If the City wishes to pursue an abstention argument, it must file a supplemental brief addressing that issue within 10 days.
